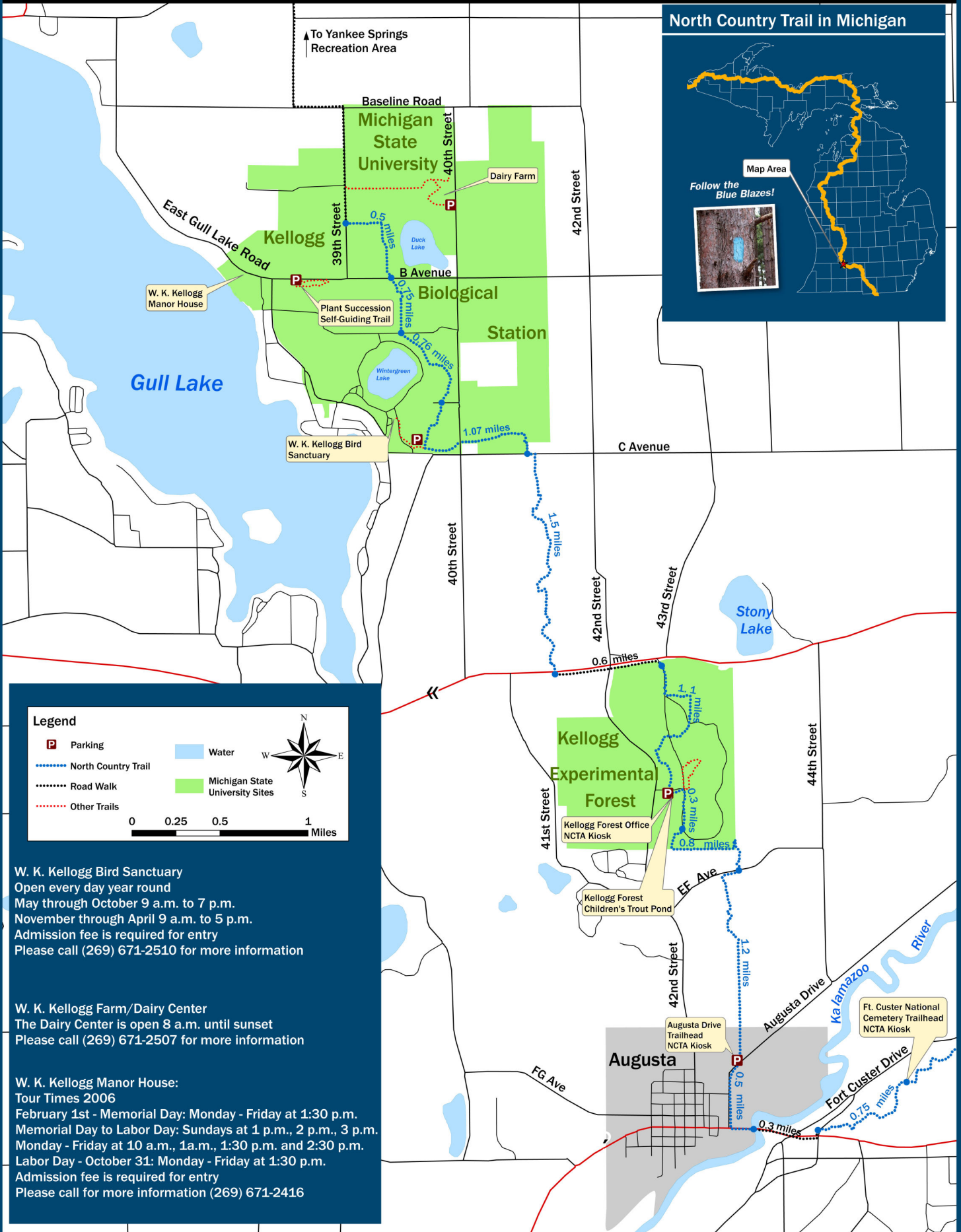


# North Country National Scenic Trail



When complete, the North Country National Scenic Trail will be the longest continuous hiking trail in the United States spanning more than 4,600 miles in all.

Designed as a premier National Scenic Trail, similar to the Appalachian Trail, it links scenic, natural, recreation, historic and cultural areas through New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, and North Dakota.

The National Park Service administers the Trail in cooperation with all levels of government as well as private interests and the North Country Trail Association.

The North Country Trail Association is a membership-driven, not-for-profit group committed to developing, maintaining and promoting the North Country National Scenic Trail through a national network of volunteers, chapters, partner organizations and government agencies.
