

# Ludington State Park

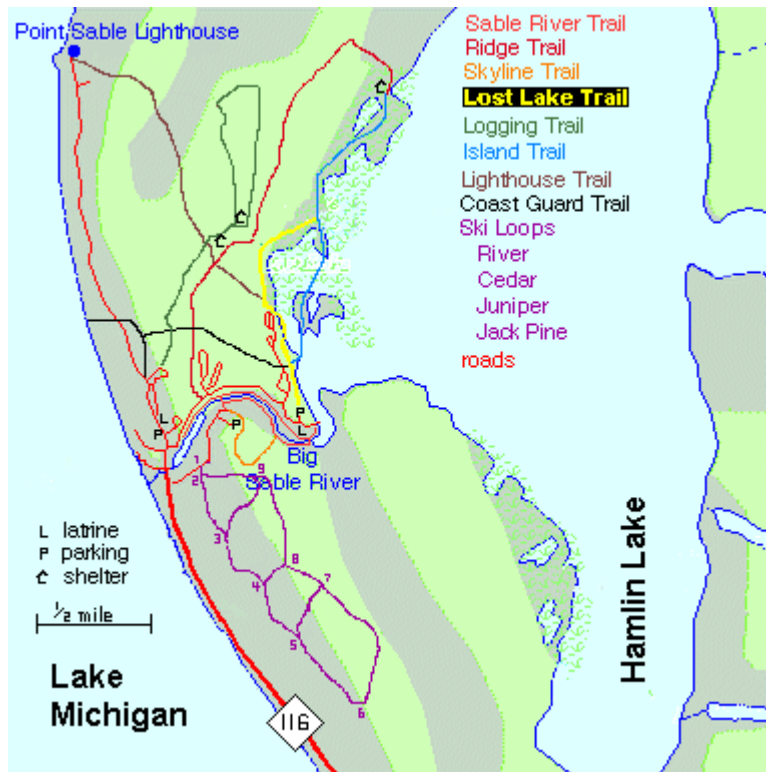
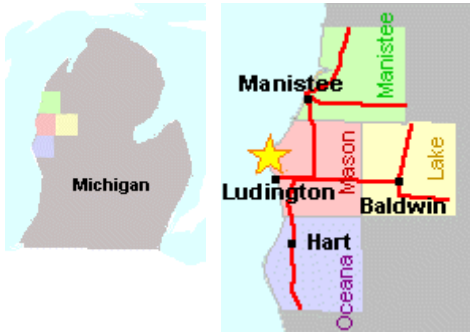

On US 10, drive through downtown Ludington until the road dead ends at Lakeshore Dr. Turn north (right) and continue out of town. This becomes M-116. This route ends at the State Park. The Logging Trail leaves the north end of the Pines Campground Loop.

Question 2. What is the shape of the structure at the connection of the 'eye' on the Logging Trail?

Ludington State Park has 22 miles of trails, Lake Michigan and Hamlin Lake beaches, year round activities, and extensive facilities. Their maps are available at the entrance.
