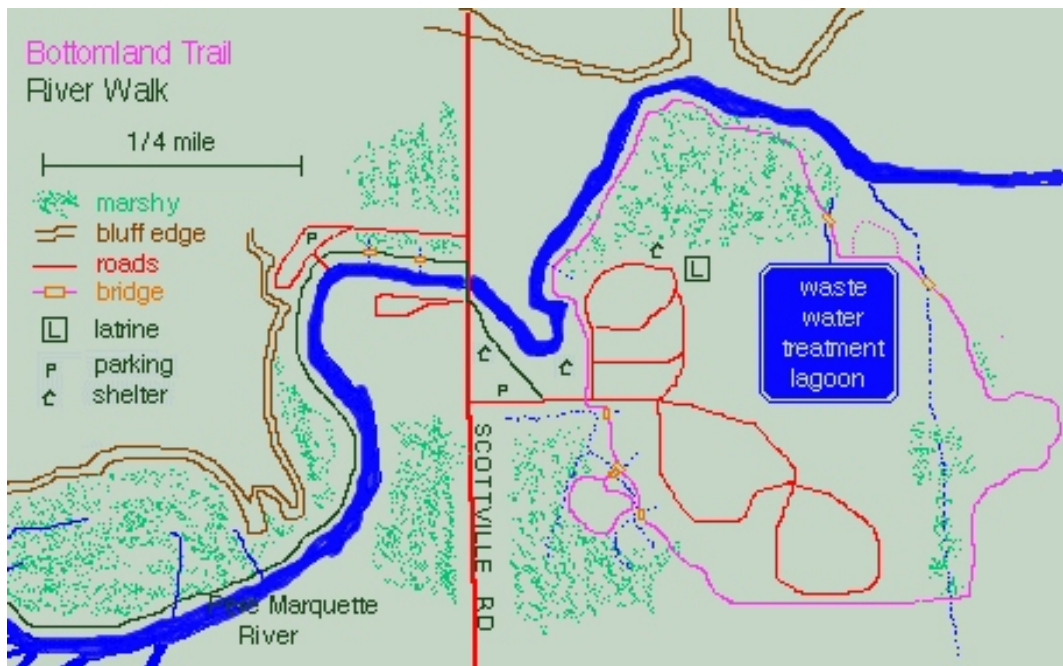

Question 7. What colors are the vanes of the antique windmill in the Old Engine Club Area?

Parking is free on either side of the road. Follow the Bottomland Trail to get this answer. Minimum distance required to get the answer to the question about 1/2 mile. Scottville Riverside Park is maintained by the City of Scottville, 231-757-4304. There are about 2 1/2 miles of trail, fishing in the Pere Marquette River, and camping. You might combine your hike with a visit to the park on August 7-8 for the Old Engine Show.
