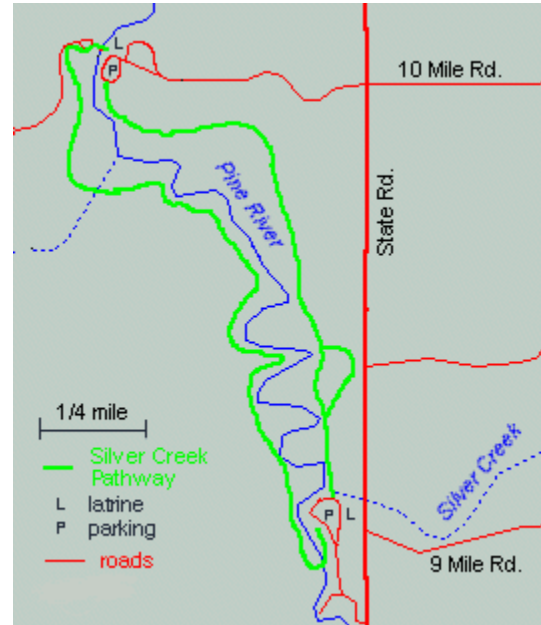

From the village of Luther take State Road north. The access and campground at the south end of the loop is directly west of the 9-Mile Rd. crossing. Or continue to 10-Mile Rd. and turn west to park where the road dead-ends at the Pine River. There are campsites at this location too.



Question 5. How many structural bridges are on this loop? Buried culverts, logs, retaining walls, etc. do not count. The 2 river bridges do count.

There is no fee to park or hike this trail. You will need to hike the entire 4 mile loop to answer the question, but you can begin your hike from either end. Silver Creek is within the Pere Marquette State Forest and is maintained by the Michigan DNR. Campsites are self-pay.
