- Meeting called to order by Gary @ 1004
- Introductions, several new people attending
- Gary gave an explanation of why we are meeting in Gaylord – to give new members a chance to attend a meeting without traveling across the state.
- Approval of Minutes from March 2, 2006 meeting
- Financial Report – current balance \$1996.76
- Gary announced that our guest speaker from DNR is unavailable because of fire training
- Lyle gave a brief report on the Buckeye Trail work and the Roving Trail Crew. An invitation was given to join us on the trail project in the UP in late summer. More information will be sent out at a later date.
- Gary gave an explanation of the National Trails System, showed a map of the trails system.
